COLLAGE making

HOW TO MAKE A COLLAGE

Have some fun and make a collage piece of art with magazines you have around your home!

EQUIPMENT YOU WILL NEED:

- A selection of magazines with colour pictures, writing etc.
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Glue stick
- Something to make your picture on such as: card, paper or a canvas
- A picture or photograph of the collage picture you wish to create be that a landscape scene, a flower, an animal or bird ... the choice is yours.

METHOD:

Draw your picture out roughly with a pencil on your paper, card or canvas for example for a landscape scene you would need to draw in your horizon, the hills, a river etc.

You can then start to look through your magazines to find the coloured paper you want to use to make your picture.

Then cut or tear small paper strips of your choice and glue them on to your picture.

Build up your picture gradually for example different colour blue paper strips for the sky or water in your picture.

Take your time and enjoy the picture developing in front of your eyes ☐

It is always good to stand back from your picture as you build it up to get a different view of what you are making....

There is no going wrong as you can always glue more paper over and build up the picture so relax, enjoy and have some fun!!

When you have finished stand back and take a look at the piece of art work you have created
